

# LISBON FROST (ARCCIT 1639)

## STRICTLY EXPERIMENTAL

### KEY ATTRIBUTES

Seedless Frost Lisbon lemon selection

### TREE CHARACTERISTICS

Very vigorous, cold hardy trees, which is highly productive with good fruit size and quality

### FRUIT SIZE

Slightly larger than Eureka

### EXTERNAL APPEARANCE

Shape is elliptical to oblong with a prominent nipple. Rind is of medium thickness and smoother than Eureka.

### INTERNAL APPEARANCE

### FRUIT QUALITY DATA

### SEED

Initial results indicate the selection is seedless

### CROSS POLLINATION ABILITY

Very low

### PRODUCTION YIELD

70 - 80 tons per hectare  
(10 year old trees - 417 trees/ha)
