CITRICOM001 – EARLY NAVEL

VARIETY IS PROTECTED UNDER U.S. PVP LAWS

Citricom001 distinguishes itself as an early-maturing navel variety, characterized by a small closed internal navel.

It boasts higher quality and superior fruit size when compared to other early navel selections, such as Fukumoto, Newhall, and Navelina, among others.

The fruit adopts a large, round shape, developing a deep orange external colour as it matures. Internally, the flesh displays an enticing orange hue and a delicate texture.

Its flavour profile stands out with exceptional sweetness, well balanced acidity, and a good maturity ratio.

In the Southern Hemisphere, Citricom001 can be harvested from mid-April to mid-May, while in the Northern Hemisphere, the harvest period extends from mid-October to mid-November.

Citricom001 is both self-incompatible and seedless. Mature orchards are expected to yield in the range of 50 to 60 tons per hectare, although no current commercial data is available.
